What does it cost?

Home Care Packages are subsidised by the Federal Department of Health. Your contribution towards the package is negotiable.

If you have been assessed as eligible for a package by the Aged Care Assessment Team (ACAT) and have been granted a package from My Aged Care you can have an Agreement relevant to your approved level of care.

An income tested fee may be applicable following income assessment by Centrelink.



Our Care Services Coordinator and care staff are able to cater to the needs of the CALD (culturally and linguistically diverse) members of our community.

You will be provided with a personalised budget so that you can see how much funding is available.

You let us know how you would like this funding to be spent.

Your Home Care Package is individually designed to your immediate care needs but can be changed if your needs and choices change later.
