COMMONWEALTH HOME SUPPORT PROGRAM (CHSP)

Federal Department of Health - 65yrs/over

Offers basic support and care services to frail older people to assist them to be more independent at home, enhance their quality of life and prevent or delay the inappropriate admission to residential care.

Services include:

- Respite Care including In-home overnight respite, centre-based day care respite, emergency and flexible respite
- Allied Health Services (Physiotherapy/Podiatry)
- Community Nursing
- Domestic Assistance
- Personal Care
- Social support (individual or group)
- Meal preparation
- Accompanying to essential health services
- Help in accessing relevant mainstream services (information, language assistance)

COMMUNITY CARE PROGRAM

Department of Communities, Child Safety and Disability Services - under 65yrs (State)

This program supports and maintains a person's ability to live independently within the community as well as sustain and support carers to continue in their caring role. Available services are the same as those of the program above.



HOME CARE PACKAGES (HCP)

Federal Department of Health

Packages assist people to remain living at home for as long as possible. The service is available to people as approved by ACAT (Aged Care Assessment Team) through My Aged Care (1800 200 422 or www.myagedcare.gov.au).

Home Care Level 1- 2
People with low level care needs

Home Care Level 3- 4
People with high level care needs

Packages offer a range of services provided in accordance to an individualised care plan. These packages are delivered on a Consumer Directed Care basis where the client identifies the goals and the manner in which the service and support is to be provided.
