HOME CARE PACKAGE (HCP) PROGRAM

Services are tailored to assist clients on level 1, 2, 3 or 4 packages in continuing to live at home independently. They are affordable, timely and respond to clients' needs.

Clinical, allied health and wellness and lifestyle choices are part of the services provided under the HCP program.

We strongly believe in maintaining great relationships between care staff and the client.

COMMONWEALTH HOME SUPPORT PROGRAM (CHSP)

Offers basic support and care services to frail older people to assist them to be more independent at home and enhance their quality of life. We have a wellness and reablement focus to support people in continuing to live in their own homes.

Services include:

- Flexible respite (in-home or centre-based respite),
- Domestic assistance,
- Social support (in-home, individual, social groups or outings),
- Meal preparation,
- Personal care,
- Nursing,
- Physiotherapy,
- Podiatry,
- Occupational therapy,
- Social work,

These services are accessible by persons who have been assessed as eligible by My Aged Care. We can assist with this process.

QLD COMMUNITY SUPPORT SCHEME

Support is available to people under 65 years of age, who have a long term disability, chronic illness, mental health or other conditions that impact on their day to day functional capacity and ability to participate in the community.

Individuals will be required to undertake an assessment and register with the Statewide QCSS Access Point which will provide a referral to the best suited provider for that individual. The State Government has approved the delivery of support services through a consortium model. The consortium consists of GOC Care, IAWAA Inc. and Co.As.It. Contact our QCSS Coordinator to discuss eligibility for these services.

Visits can be individual or group-based and provide the chance for volunteers to make a positive difference in the lives of clients and residents.

The ACVVS is about fostering friendship and companionship for older people who may be socially isolated or disconnected from their communities. Older people from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds are matched with volunteer visitors, from similar backgrounds.
